It is an exciting time for our project since only 6 months left to the end of the project and so many things have happened in recent months.

Finally, we are proud to inform you that our project has been reported as a success story by the European Commission and it was chosen as the subject for a TV documentary on latest European research on cultural heritage preservation. The report is a coproduction between EuroNews and the European Commission, and it was aired in June 2017 - for a whole week (22 times) - in the award-winning programme Futuris, on European science, research and innovation. The documentary was broadcasted to 430 million households in 130 countries in EuroNews' thirteen broadcasting languages (English, Italian, German, Spanish, French, Portuguese, Russian, Arabic, Turkish, Persian, Greek, Ukranian and Hungarian).
